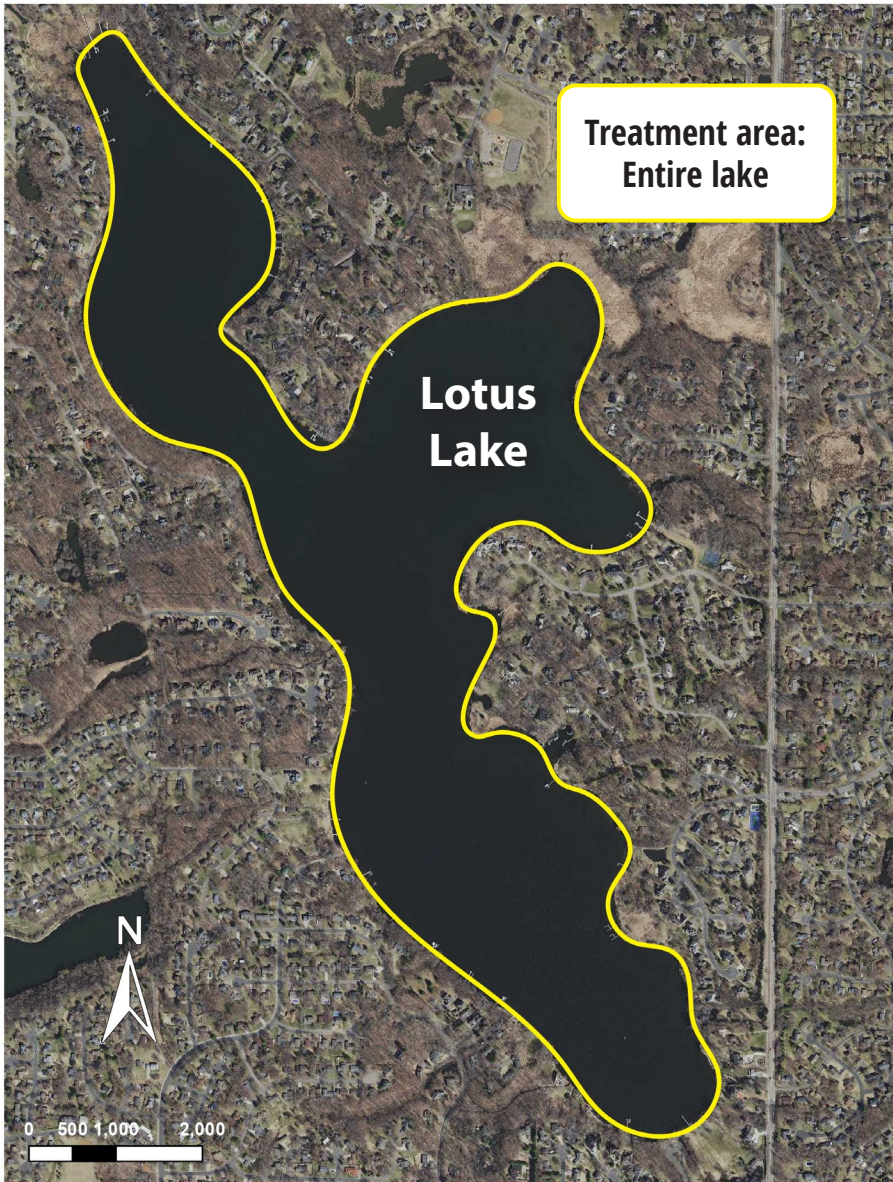


# Lotus Lake Herbicide Treatment

## April 2024



RPBCWD received a permit from the Minnesota DNR to control Eurasian Watermilfoil (EWM), an invasive aquatic plant, using an approved aquatic herbicide. This will be a whole-lake treatment.

**RPBCWD** will work with a contractor to apply an aquatic herbicide to control EWM in the lake. *The treatment will occur at no cost to residents.*

Lake water use: There are **NO** restrictions on lake water for the Fluridone dose being used.



**Swimming**  
No restriction



**Drinking**  
No restriction



**Irrigation**  
No restriction

**What:** Herbicide treatment (Fluridone)

**Where:** Within designated area(s) on lake (see map on front)

**Why:** To control Eurasian Watermilfoil, an invasive aquatic plant

**When:** **April 29<sup>th</sup>**, if weather allows
