1. Call to Order

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President Ziegler called the Board of Managers Special Meeting to order at 9:02 a.m. Louis Smith called roll as follows:

^{*}Prior to responding to the roll call, Manager Koch said he objects to the meeting on the grounds that written notice was not mailed the required eight days prior to the meeting as required by 103D.315 Subd. 11 and as a result he will not be participating as a manager but as a member of the public.

Mr. Smith stated the meeting notice did meet the requirements of a special meeting under the Open Meeting Law and also, in Legal Counsel's judgement, meets the requirements of an emergency meeting because the circumstances require the Board's immediate attention and the agenda items today require the Board's immediate attention.

2. Status of Koch v. Riley Purgatory Bluff Creek Watershed District Litigation (Board may meet in closed executive session).

Mr. Smith recommended the Board go into a closed session for the purpose of receiving confidential legal advice on the matter of Koch vs. Riley Purgatory Bluff Creek Watershed District.

Manager Pedersen moved to go into closed session to receive confidential legal advice on the matter of Koch vs. Riley Purgatory Bluff Creek Watershed District. Manager Duevel seconded the motion. <u>Upon a roll call vote</u>, the motion carried 4-0 with 1 abstention as follows:

3. Consideration of Exercise of 60-Day Extension of Closing Period (Board may meet in closed executive session).

At 9:37 a.m. the Board reconvened the public session.

Mr. Smith said Legal Counsel recommends a motion to authorize the District Administrator to make an electronic payment to Trek in the amount of \$50,000 to exercise under the assignment agreement the right of a 60-day extension on the closing period should the Administrator determine by the close of business today that no alternative agreement is available without such payment.

Manager Pedersen moved to authorize the District Administrator to make an electronic payment to Trek in the amount of \$50,000 to exercise under the assignment agreement the right of a 60-day extension on the closing period should the Administrator determine by the close of business today that no alternative agreement is available without such payment. Manager Crafton seconded the motion.

Larry Koch commented that without waiving his objections to this meeting or to the closed session he reiterates his statement that there is no need to pay any more money for any additional extension. He said he believes the terms of the agreement are actually quite clear the District is not required to close. Mr. Koch said there is no ability for either Trek or the Standals to force a closing of the transaction, not only because of the litigation but because of the process or lack thereof of actually executing the agreement and what agreement is actually in place. Mr. Koch said he does not think it is appropriate that this District go and pay more money when it does not have to do so.
