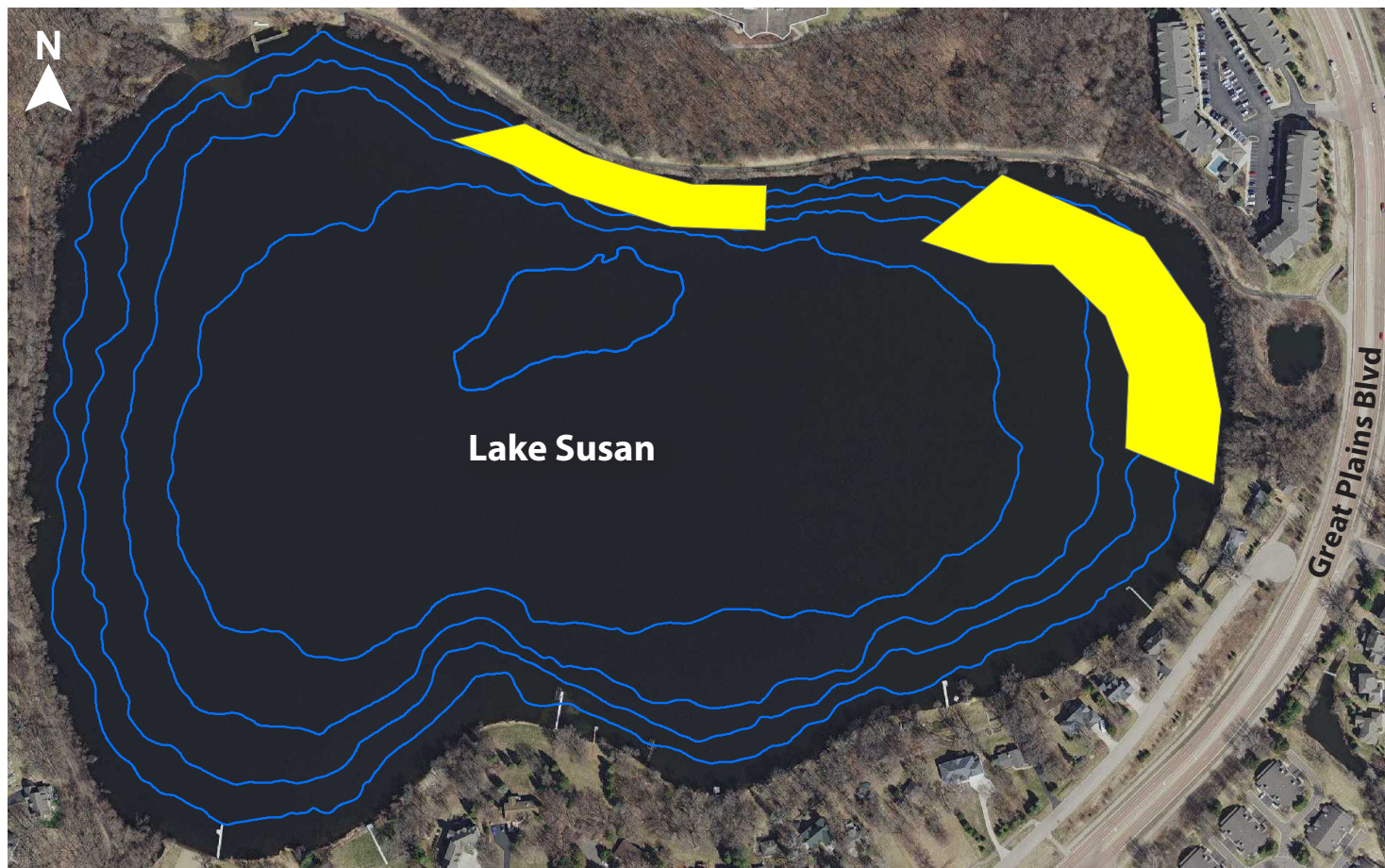




Lake Susan Herbicide Treatment

May 2023

RPBCWD received a permit from the Minnesota DNR to control Curlyleaf Pondweed (CLP), an invasive aquatic plant, using an approved aquatic herbicide. See map below for treatment areas.



Legend

-  CLP Treatment Area
-  1 meter depth contours

The treatment size is limited by MnDNR permit requirements. Surveys identify areas of highest CLP density for treatment location(s).

RPBCWD will work with a contractor to apply an aquatic herbicide to control Curlyleaf Pondweed in the lake. *The treatment will occur at no cost to residents.*

What: Herbicide treatment (Flumioxazin)

Where: Within designated area(s) on lake (*see map on front*)

Why: To control Curlyleaf Pondweed, an invasive aquatic plant

When: **May 18th**, if weather allows. Delays/rescheduling will be posted online at rpbcd.org/AIScontrol

After treatment, the MnDNR recommends not using the water for these activities for these number of days:

 **Irrigation**
5 days
