


Lake Susan Herbicide Treatment May 2023

RPBCWD received a permit from the Minnesota DNR to control Curlyleaf Pondweed (CLP), an invasive aguatic plant, using an approved aguatic herbicide. See map below for treatment areas.



CLP Treatment Area

1 meter depth contours

identify areas of highest CLP density for treatment location(s).

RPBCWD will work with a contractor to apply an aquatic herbicide to control Curlyleaf Pondweed in the lake. The treatment will occur at no cost to residents.

What: Herbicide treatment (Flumioxazin)

Where: Within designated area(s) on lake (see map on front)

To control Curlyleaf Pondweed, an invasive aquatic plant Why:
