

RESOLUTION NO. 23-060
Riley-Purgatory-Bluff Creek Watershed District
Board of Managers

Authorizing execution of cost share agreement with Hackamore Brewing for a pervious paver patio and installation of native vegetation.

Manager Pedersen offered the following resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Manager Crafton:

WHEREAS Riley-Purgatory-Bluff Creek Watershed District's 2018 10-Year Watershed Management Plan identifies and allocates funding to implement a cost-share program to provide incentives for BMPs;

WHEREAS RPBCWD staff reviewed the application for the proposed pervious patio and native vegetation planting and determined the project would meet RPBCWD goals to minimize the negative impacts of erosion and sedimentation, to minimize pollutant loading to water resources, and to promote infiltration to reduce runoff, improve water quality, and promote aquifer recharge.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the RPBCWD Board of Managers authorizes the administrator, with advice of counsel, to enter the attached contract with Hackamore Brewing, substantially in the form of the attached, for a cost not to exceed \$34,176.00, as finalized with such nonsubstantive changes as are necessary to implement the intent of the managers.
