# Wetland Restoration & Flood Mitigation Project

#### **Benefits:**

- Restore 7 Acres of wetlands and enhance remainder of wetland
- Reduce volume, rate, pollution loads to Bluff Creek (impaired water)
- Remove 3 properties from flood zone
- Connect public with the resource

#### Costs:

~ \$950,000

(\$111,870 watershed based funding)










Lower Riley Creek Restoration







Use rainwater to conserve groundwater and promote healthy habitat. Explore the Fire Station grounds to see how the City is reducing its water usage. You can do the following:



Install a rain barrel or cistern. Collecting and reusing rainwater reduces ground water use.



Plant turfgrass alternatives. Low-mow and native grasses need less water, fertilizer, and pesticides resulting in less polluted runoff to local rivers, lakes, and






